Tasks will be laid out on a grid, and activities can be signed off by an adult once completed. Children will receive certificates in school when they reach milestones of achievement; these will be handed out in our Friday class celebration assemblies. Children could do as many or as few of the tasks per week as they like, in order to fit in with your busy family lives.

Parents, we ask that you encourage and support your child but please do not complete the activity for them.

There are 3 rewards that you can get:

Bronze - complete 5 tasks

Silver - complete 10 tasks

Gold - complete all the term's 15 tasks

Once you have completed your first five tasks bring your journal (grid) in to be signed by your class teacher and collect your award. Continue to pick activities and work your way to silver, gold and platinum. Each time you complete 5 more tasks bring your journal in to show us! You will be given a new set of tasks to complete in the Spring term.

Attached is the homework grid for your child(ren)'s class. We hope that the children will have fun completing their tasks and that you will enjoy the homework as a family.

This task-based homework will run in addition to the usual spellings, reading and times table practice that is currently expected of the children.
