Internet Safety

Please can we ask parents/carers to be vigilant of a game children may be playing/watching called Poppy Playtime. The game features a toy called Huggy Wuggy, who lures children into an abandoned toy factory, making them feel bad because he is lonely. He wants to hug children, but actually squeezes them to death and bites them. There has been a case of a reception-aged child watching and re-enacting it, which is not appropriate. It disassociates what should be a loving act (hugging) with something completely the opposite.

Reminders

As we are still experiencing warm weather, please ensure your child brings a named sun hat to school and applies sun cream before coming to school. Your child is welcome to have named sun cream in school and can apply this themselves throughout the day.
